REQUIREMENTS

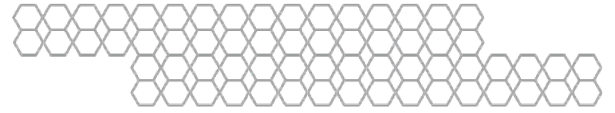
- + Bachelor's degree with 10 years of documented experience in the sexual assault field (required without Master's degree.)
