

Part-time Sexual Assault Regional & Outreach Coordinator

HelpLine is seeking an energetic, self-motivated, and highly organized individual to provide rape crisis services and outreach in a regional area (Delaware, Morrow, Crawford, Wyandot, and neighboring counties). This position provides direct service and advocacy to sexual assault survivors. Responsibilities include building collaboration and overseeing regional outreach efforts. This position will also assist with on-call advocacy coverage. The program has three offices spread throughout our four-county service region (Delaware, Mt. Gilead, Upper Sandusky); the home office could be in Delaware with work offices flexible between all sites.

REQUIREMENTS

- + Bachelor's degree in social work or related fields required. Advocate credentials/social work licensure preferred
- + Two years' experience in field of mental health or human services, preferably serving crime victims, specifically sexual violence, family violence/intimate partner violence
- + Excellent communication, organization, computer/technology knowledge, community networking skills, and ability to provide supervision to volunteers desired
- + This is a part time position (20 hours per week) and requires flexibility in scheduling. Position includes some evening and weekend shifts
- + Reliable transportation required, as well as driver insurability, and ability to meet HelpLine driving standards. Required to pass a BCI background check

PREFERRED

- + Individuals with experience working within the anti-violence field, working with specific, underserved populations are encouraged to apply
- + Applicants who have completed HelpLine's SARN volunteer training and/or required training for Ohio's rape crisis centers are encouraged to apply
