# Sexual Assault Response Network (SARN) Outreach Coordinator, Crawford and Wyandot Counties

HelpLine is seeking an energetic, self-motivated, and highly organized individual to coordinate our rape crisis services (SARN program) and outreach in Crawford and Wyandot counties (CW). SARN CW Coordinator will provide direct service and advocacy to sexual assault survivors mainly in Crawford and Wyandot counties and will assist, as needed, throughout our service region (Delaware, Morrow, Crawford and Wyandot counties). The SARN CW Coordinator will coordinate and develop community and stakeholder partnerships and trainings to grow SARN services in the area. This position will coordinate outreach efforts to support SARN services and assist with on-call advocacy coverage in our service area.

## REQUIREMENTS

- + Bachelor's degree in social work or related fields required. Advocate credentials/social work licensure preferred
- + Two years' experience in fields of mental health or human services, preferably serving crime victims, specifically sexual violence, family violence/intimate partner violence
- + Excellent communication, organization, computer/technology knowledge, community networking skills, and ability to provide supervision to volunteers desired
- + This is a full time position (40 hours per week) and requires flexibility in scheduling. Position includes some evening and weekend shifts
- + Reliable transportation required, as well as driver insurability, and ability to meet HelpLine driving standards. Required to pass a BCI background check

- + Individuals with experience working within the anti-violence field, working with specific, underserved populations are encouraged to apply

- + Applicants who have completed HelpLine's SARN volunteer training and/or required training for Ohio's rape crisis centers are encouraged to apply
