ABOUT GUARDIANS FOR GOOD

Guardians for Good (GFG) is a HelpLine community that is open to anyone who supports HelpLine through **sponsorship**, **service**, and **social advocacy** within our eight-county service territory.

HelpLine prevention programs broaden our knowledge of individuals and families in crisis, and the challenges around the issues of suicide, sexual assault, relationships, and other interpersonal violence.

GFG derives its strength from integrating the expertise of our staff with the energy of our community members. Ultimately, Guardians contribute to the overall financial health and wealth of HelpLine that could otherwise not be achieved, ensuring that we remain viable and sustainable.





GFG HISTORY

Launched in 2018, the concept for Guardians for Good (GFG) was built upon the desire to engender a sense of community among those who invested time, talent, and treasure at HelpLine. Going beyond listing names in a report, we sought engagement on a deeper level. We wanted to open up our organization so that our work became familiar. We wanted to ignite a passion to champion hope, help, and healing for our entire community. Most importantly, we wanted to recognize those community members - often unsung heroes - who work alongside of us to achieve positive community impact. What we envisioned then has now manifested into an annual event that recognizes those we like to call our Guardians for Good.

Over the past five years, the GFG awards celebration is held annually on Giving Tuesday to highlight those who've demonstrated superior service, sponsorship, and social advocacy on behalf of HelpLine and its affiliate programs. The event also serves as a platform to:

- Highlight the impact of our prevention, crisis intervention, postvention, information & referral, and volunteer programs.
- Promote awareness and heighten sensitivity about suicide, depression, and mental health and its impact on families, friends, schools, and communities.

Each year, ABC 6 News Co-Anchors Stacia Naquin and Bob Kendrick serve as the event emcees, bringing light-hearted energy and visibility to the celebration. The program also includes video presentations to highlight the work of the honorees and their direct impact.

Overall, the program is attended by a diverse audience who represent a broad cross-section of public and private sectors from school administrators, nonprofit and business leaders, clergy, elected officials, and community members.


